


Furano ski area boasts "Kitanomine Zone" and "Furano Zone" that challenge all abilities and offer every skier the perfect course.

Max.29°/Av.15°/700m
This bunny course is ideal for mogul skiers.

Spies Course

Max.32°/Av.15°/3,300m
An exciting long run. You can enjoy night skiing as well.

Ladies' Downhill Course

Max.32°/Av.14°/2,410m
Enjoy breathtaking views of Mt. Tokachi Dake and Taimnerusan Mountains.

Giant Course

Max.32°/Av.19°/700m
Suitable for advanced skiers and snowboarders and offers good practice for intermediates.

Todomatsu Course

Max.25°/Av.11°/700m
Try the run with the poles set by Kinoshita Kinoru, the 4-time Olympic team lead, Jan to early Mar.

Prince Course

Max.18°/Av.8°/900m
This wide course is ideal for beginners and snowboarding lessons.
